5. **MATTERS BEFORE THE BOARD**

a. **Consideration of engagement of Timothy Day CPA for accounting services for year ending December 31, 2023**

By **MOTION**, second, and unanimous vote the approved the engagement of Timothy Day CPA for accounting services for year ending December 31, 2023.

b. **Consideration of engagement of McMahan and Associates LLC for auditing services for year ending December 31, 2023**

By **MOTION**, second, and unanimous vote the Board approved the engagement of McMahan and Associates for auditing services for year ending December 31, 2023.

c. **Consideration of engagement of Anchor QEA for preliminary engineering services for the Septic to Sewer project to be paid for from funds received through the Windy Gap Environmental Fund grant**

District Manager Nicholls stated that the District previously did an official bid for engineering services before the District started pursuing the Septic to Sewer Conversion Project. Anchor QEA was selected by the Board. Anchor QEA, represented by Bob Orsatti, has put together a proposal for the big picture roll out of the completion of the District. Using the aerial survey, staff knowledge and potential age of existing septic systems a ranking system will be created to identify and prioritize the phases of the project. Additionally, initial engineering on the first phase is included. The District intends to use the data to pursue additional funding opportunities. A discussion ensued regarding the Lakeridge area, aerial survey status, USDA requirements, and state funding. By **MOTION**, second, and unanimous vote the Board approved the engagement of Anchor QEA for preliminary engineering services for the Septic to Sewer Conversion project.

6. **PUBLIC COMMENT**

Matt Chidley and James Chidley owners of 1205 GCR 4739 and 161 GCR 472 introduced themselves. Their properties were included in the Lakeridge line extension on County Road 472. They noted that the Board granted them an extension to their 5-year connection agreement to allow more time for connection though October 1, 2023. They stated that two contractors have informed them that connection was not possible and they are looking for a resolution to the situation. A lengthy discussion ensued. The Board informed the Chidley's they are expecting them to connect, but they can try for a variance if they desire. However, they will need to get a bid in order to do so, but noted that they would need very compelling documentation to have one granted.

9. **SUPERINTENDENT REPORT**

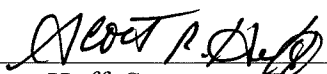
Superintendent Gibboni presented the Superintendent report.
